

HOW IT WORKS

It's very simple! Prague City Pass is a Prague tourism system that provides free admission without waiting to the most popular attractions in the city.

The most important attractions are included in PRAGUE CITY PASS:

- Prague Castle Old Royal Palace with Vladislav Hall,
 St. George's Basilica, Golden Lane with Daliborka Tower,
 St. Vitus Cathedral. The ticket is valid for 2 days from first entry.
- Jewish museum in Prague Maisel Synagogue, Spanish Synagogue, Pinkas Synagogue, Old Jewish Cemetery, Klausen Synagogue, Ceremonial Hall. The ticket is valid for 7 days from first entry.

Prague City Pass holders also receive a free guided bus tour through the centre of Prague, free river cruise and many other discounts and benefits.

Prague City Pass and your passport – two essential travel documents for your trip to Prague! Once you purchase the Prague City Pass you can head straight for the entrance to Prague attractions without waiting in the queue or buying tickets. You save money as well.

PRAGUE CITY PASS exists in a variety of forms:

- The classic paper Prague City Pass is available from a wide network of sales locations, while those who purchase the pass online will have them sent to their address by post.
- Prague City Pass as a printout from your own printer.

A Prague City Pass always includes a unique numerical and EAN code to verify the validity of your pass upon entering individual attractions. A reader is used to check codes at some attractions (Prague Castle), while staff check the Prague City Pass personally at other sites. Using Prague City Pass is fast and simple!

Prague City Pass gives you enough time to see everything at a relaxed pace. Prague City Pass is valid for 30 days following date of purchase. Attractions can be entered only once.

WHAT YOU GET

- Enjoy free admission to the most popular attractions in Prague. Take a look at the full list of sites you can visit free of charge with Prague City Pass.
- Take a free guided bus tour that begins in the centre of the city on Národní třída, a short distance from the site where the legendary Velvet Revolution, the symbol of the fall of totalitarianism in Czechoslovakia, began in 1989. The tour continues from the New Town, passing some of the most important sites in Prague, through the Old Town and the Lesser Town. The tour ends at Prague Castle, the seat of the Czech kings and presidents and the most heavily visited site in the Czech Republic.

Take a free cruise through Prague with commentary. A romantic sightseeing cruise is a unique way to see the beauty of Prague and to appreciate the comfort of transport without having to wait at zebra crossings or walking in the heat of summer. Boats have been cruising on the Vltava for over 140 years and you get the great opportunity to experience the way people used to travel years ago.
